THIS UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH AGREEMENT is made by (Name of Principal Investigator) _____ and between (Name of Student) _____ of ISNC.

In consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained and intending to be bound, we agree as follows:

Section 0. Preamble.

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide terms and conditions that the Principal Investigator _____ and undergraduate student _____ (individually “Party”, collectively “Parties”) agree to apply to the performance of research under a Task Order. It is the intention of the Parties that the research contemplated herein, and more specifically described in the Statement of Work (Research Project Proposal), is for the purpose of advancing scientific knowledge and to aid in the scientific education of undergraduate students through the opportunity to work on relevant and suitable research.

Further, the Parties understand and agree that the terms and conditions of this Agreement are specific to this Agreement and the research described in the Statement of Work and will not necessarily be used as precedent for any other sponsored research agreement that the Parties may enter into in the future.

Section I. Definitions.

1.1 “Task Order” (Letter of Registration and Institutional Ethics Committee) means the document that authorizes performance of specific research under this Agreement.

Task Orders shall use the sample format provided in Attachment A and include a scope of work as provided for in Section 5.1.

1.2 “Research Project” means research to be performed under a Task Order by staff members of Ibn Sina National College, and/or by staff members of External Institution as described in a Statement of Work for the Task Order. The Research Project is undertaken on a reasonable effort basis in accordance with the research and educational mission of ISNC and ISNC-RC.

1.3 “Statement of Work” means the document describing the technical research effort to be performed under a Task Order.

1.4 “Staff Members of ISNC” means employees, independent contractors, subcontractors, consultants, student assistants, and students of ISNC.

1.5 “Project Intellectual Property” means any intellectual property, including without limitation any inventions, improvements, and discoveries, including all computer software, works, material, and data, whether protectable by patent or copyright, created and/or first reduced to practice in the course of performance of work under a Task Order or other work performed under this Agreement.

1.6 “Background Intellectual Property” means all ISNC, and third party intellectual property, including but not limited to inventions, patents, trademarks, copyrights, computer software, and tangible analysis techniques created and/or first reduced to practice prior to or outside the scope of this Agreement or any Task Order.

1.7 “ISNC Sole Intellectual Property” means individually and collectively all Project Intellectual Property that is created and/or first reduced to practice solely by ISNC Staff Members, Company and ISNC Student.

1.8 “Joint Intellectual Property” means individually and collectively all Project Intellectual Property which is created and/or first reduced to practice jointly by Staff Members of ISNC, external Sponsor and Undergraduate Student of ISNC.

1.9 “Proprietary Information” means any data or information having commercial value which may include but not be limited to data, databases, product plans, strategies, forecasts, research procedures, marketing techniques and materials, customer names and other information related to customers, price-lists, pricing policies, and financial information which the Parties consider sensitive and which is not generally known to the public.

Section 2. Term.

2.1 The term of this Agreement is ___ (__) years from the Effective Date and may be renewed by written agreement of the Parties. Each Task Order under this Agreement shall indicate the term of such project. To the extent that a particular Task Order does not continue beyond the expiration date of this Agreement, this Agreement shall not be automatically extended to be co-terminus with respect to such Task Order.

Section 3. Benefit for Undergraduate Student from Research.

Note: The benefit to student from their involvement in the staff initiated research shall be discussed and decided before they embark on the project as follows. The following benefits could be bestowed upon the student after completion of their assigned task as decided by the research supervisor.

Certificate of participation in Research from the PRT/ISNC-RC.

Letter of Recommendation from the research supervisor.

Conference Oral Presentation.

Conference Poster Presentation.

Grades/points for participation in research.

Acknowledgement in the research output publication.

Co-author in the publication.
